I-95 Rehabilitation Project Virtual Public Meeting on Thursday, December 2, 2021

Wilmington – The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) will hold a virtual informational meeting on Thursday, December 2, 2021 at 6:00pm. The session will provide an overview of the upcoming start of Phase 2 of the project, with new traffic patterns beginning the weekend of December 10-12, weather permitting.

As with Phase 1 of the project, throughout construction, at least one lane in each direction of I-95 will remain open, and ramp closures will be staggered to continuously maintain access in and out of the city.

Phase 2 of the project will include construction work on the southbound lanes of I-95 from the Brandywine River Bridge to the I-95/I-495 split south of Wilmington.
