UPDATE

I-95 SOUTHBOUND and 2nd STREET ON RAMP - WEEKEND CLOSURE

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) announces to motorists that paving, striping and related work between the Exit 8/ US 202 interchange and the I-495 split will require the **weekend closure** of I-95 Southbound through Wilmington and the 2nd Street on ramp to I-95 Southbound.

NOTE: The closure scheduled for this weekend, September 30th to October 3rd, is being postponed due the remnants of Hurricane Ian moving through the region.

Revised Dates (pending weather) and Location:

I-95 Southbound: Weekend Closure -- 8 PM Friday, **October 7 to 5 AM Monday, October 10.**

2nd Street on ramp to I-95 Southbound: Weekend Closure -- 8 PM Friday, **October 7 to 5 AM Monday, October 10.**

Detours:

I-95 Southbound - Motorists coming from Pennsylvania will be directed to use I-495 Southbound. Local traffic entering I-95 SB will be detoured off at Exit 8/ US 202, and directed to SB 141 back to I-95 SB.



2nd Street on ramp – Motorists will be directed to MLK Boulevard to US 13 South to I-495 South.



UPON I-95 RE-OPENING ON MONDAY OCTOBER 10:

- Exit Ramp 7B (Sr 52/Delaware Avenue Northbound) will be OPEN
- Southbound I-95 Traffic will travel in the newly constructed southbound lanes, with a single lane available through Wilmington.
