I-95 Restore the Corridor Project Work to Require Nightly Closures Beginning Monday, June 13

Wilmington – Continuing work on the I-95 Restore the Corridor project will require several nights of rolling road blocks and full closures beginning Monday, June 13, 2022.

Rolling road blocks of 15 minute intervals will occur on I-95 southbound from 8:00pm to 5:00am on Monday, June 13, and Tuesday, June 14, in the vicinity of the 2nd Street on-ramp. Traffic will be temporarily stopped during these hours while barrier walls are moved.

I-95 southbound will be detoured onto Exit 6 from 8:00pm to 5:00am on Wednesday, June 15, and Thursday, June 16. Traffic will be temporarily stopped during these hours while barrier walls are moved.

Additionally, the 2nd Street on-ramp to I-95 southbound will be closed from 9:00pm to 7:00am on Friday, June 17 and Friday, June 24.

Motorists are encouraged to use I-495 southbound or follow the signed Blue Route detour from within the city of Wilmington shown below to avoid delays during these times. For more information and updates on the project, please visit restorethecorridor.com.
